

PiXL Middle School Offer 2020/21

As a Middle School we have chosen to give you access to all of PiXL Primary and PiXL Secondary resources. To help, we have highlighted some resources we feel would be most beneficial to you for KS3. Included are two QR codes which will take you through to our Secondary overview booklet and the Primary offer document for 20-21. PiXL (Partners in Excellence) is a partnership of over 3,000 schools comprising of around 1,600 secondary schools, 550 sixth forms, 1,000 primary schools and 60 providers of alternative education. Together, we share best practice to raise standards and to give students a better future and brighter hope.

We want young people to:

- Achieve the best outcomes they can - we call this **Currency**.
- Be the best people they can become - we call that **Character**.
- Be kind, respectful and live without causing harm to others - we call that **Culture**.

Founded by Sir John Rowling, PiXL emerged from school improvement programme, the London Challenge, in 2004. When government funding for the initiative ceased in 2007, the 50 member schools at that time decided voluntarily to continue with its model of collaboration around leadership and shared resources. PiXL has since grown to become the largest network of schools in England and Wales.

- The launch of PiXL TV to bring the power of our network directly to your school; docu-series on key pedagogical strategies, as well as explorations into such issues as curriculum planning and the gender gap, filmed in PiXL schools and available to watch on demand.
- KS3 specific resources including PiXL Spine for all subjects.
- Renewed focus on academic writing and reading, to include updates to Unlock and the Code.
- Continued focus on our character offer, including updates to the PiXL Edge programme.
- A strong focus on Teaching and Learning, including a new platform to collect and share research and practice across all phases.
- Oracy and debating, including new debating mats, across all subjects

- PiXL Change: precise pastoral interventions, including attendance and behaviour management.
- Leadership podcasts and book club will bring the latest thinking directly to you.
- Ability to book and pay for bespoke KS3 associate and subject associate support.
