PiXL (Partners in Excellence) is a partnership of over 3,000 schools comprising of 1,600 secondary schools, 550 sixth forms, 1,000 primary schools and 60 providers of alternative education. Together, we share best practice to raise standards and to give students a better future and brighter hope.

PiXL6 began in 2014 and aims to bring sixth form teachers and leaders together to share good practice and to hear about specific post-16 strategies and resources. Founded by Sir John Rowling, PiXL emerged from school improvement programme, the London Challenge, in 2004. When government funding for the initiative ceased in 2007, the 50 member schools at that time decided voluntarily to continue with its model of collaboration around leadership and shared resources. PiXL has since grown to become the largest network of schools in England and Wales.
