Due to the current Regional Leader taking up the new role of Executive Headteacher, an exciting opportunity has arisen for a committed, driven, enthusiastic educationalist to join the PiXL staff as a Regional Leader. This is a senior leadership position within PiXL as part of a team of eight Regional Leaders, who work under the leadership and direction of the Head of Regional Teams. This team oversees the work of our Associates to ensure that we build on our associate model of excellence, and quality assures the 10,000 hours of conversations with school leaders across the country. The Regional Team is a relatively new team, having been formed in 2020 and, since that time, they have been very much the 'engine' room of PiXL. They have brought together the intelligence from schools right into the heart of the organisation, so that we make better-informed decisions to meet the needs of our schools.

PiXL is at a pivotal time in its development and growth, as it seeks to serve a growing partnership of over 2,500 schools with a reach of around 170,000 staff and over a million young people. It is these leaders and young people who we serve so we can help bring about a 'better future and brighter hope' for them. We work in schools across the UK and in all sectors, from Primary to Post-16. Since 2020, there has been significant change in the organisation, including a new CEO, and a renewed focus on PiXL's three aims which remain the same and are:

- to influence leadership at all levels, regionally and nationally, as the best way to improve schools;
- to equip school leaders to be agents of change and betterment.

Applicants must be able to think strategically, as well as operationally, to implement what has been agreed. The Regional Leader role is pivotal to the work we do and requires the applicant to be able to work independently and as part of the wider team.
