WHY CHOOSE THIS PROGRAMME?

- We will expose delegates to leading thinkers, authors and leaders from the world of education and a range of other high performing organisations to encourage reflection, self-awareness and maximise leadership strengths.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

This training opportunity aims to inspire delegates to take on the characteristics of exceptional PiXL Senior Leaders. The programme is broken down into four parts: a two-day residential launch, a one-day regional conference, a national one-day conference and then a two-day immersion experience in another PiXL school.

Working individually and with other delegates, you will have the chance to deal with simulated critical incidents, solve 'real-life' leadership problems and think both strategically and creatively.

The content will focus on:

- Leading when it all goes wrong;
- Leading when it all goes right;
- Learning from High Performance organisations;
- Leading beyond your comfort zone;
- Making effective decisions;
- Leading and developing others.
